Personal data that we process

GlobalCloudPayments B.V. processes your personal data because you make
use of our services and / or because you provide the personal data yourself.

For what purpose and on what basis we process personal data

GlobalCloudPayments B.V. processes your personal data for the
following purposes:

- To support the transaction you have made.
- To be able to call or e-mail you if necessary to carry out our services.
- For enabling you to open an account.
- To deliver goods and services to you.
- - GlobalCloudPayments B.V. analyzes your behavior on the website
in order to improve the website and to tailor the range of products and
services to your preferences.
- - GlobalCloudPayments B.V. tracks your surfing behavior on
various websites with which we tailor our products and services to
your needs.
- GlobalCloudPayments B.V. also processes personal data if we are
legally obliged to do so, such as information that we need for our
administration.



How long do we store personal data

GlobalCloudPayments B.V. stores your personal data for 7 years, in accordance with PCI DSS and / or legal term and no longer than is strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which your data is collected.

Sharing of personal data with third parties

GlobalCloudPayments B.V. provides data to third parties only if this is necessary to comply with the law and regulations of payment schemes / banks.



Cookies

GlobalCloudPayments B.V. uses cookies with the aim of increasing user-friendliness. In this statement we would like to explain to you what cookies are, which cookies we use and which purpose these cookies serve.

What are cookies

A cookie is a file that is stored on your computer which enables your recognition during a subsequent visit to our website. Cookies only contain a (unique) number. They do not contain any personal data. These cookies can't be used for personal identification.

Functional and technical cookies

Functional and Technical cookies are necessary for the website of GlobalCloudPayments B.V. to function. The functional and technical cookies are placed by default without requiring a permission.

Analytical cookies

In order to give you the best user experience and to inform you in the best possible way, we would like to know how our visitors use the website. For this purpose, a Google Analytics "cookie" is placed, a small file that is stored on your computer. The information is anonymised as much as possible. Your IP address and surfing behavior remains completely anonymous. We cannot personally trace you as a result. GlobalCloudPayments B.V. uses Google cookies to track conversions on the website. You can disable the placement of cookies by setting your internet browser so that it no longer stores cookies. In addition, you can also delete all information previously stored via the settings of your browser.
